26th New Zealand Fungal Foray & Colloquium

Riverton 6th-12th May. 2012

STRICT DEADLINE: Registration and payment due by: 20th April 2012.

The 26th New Zealand Fungal Foray will be based at The Globe Backpackers and Bar and the RSA Memorial Club Hall, Riverton from Sunday 6th – Saturday 12th May. The RSA Hall is directly across the road from the Globe Backpackers, and are both in the main street of Riverton, Southland.

Riverton is a coastal town 20 minutes drive (30 km) from Invercargill, in Southland, New Zealand. It is close to the Longwood Range and, further afield, the extensive forests of southern Fiordland, the Hokonui Hills and the Eyre Mountains. Typically we'll find an abundance of collecting sites 30–90 minutes drive from Riverton.

The foray will begin Sunday evening 6th May and end on Saturday morning 12th May. Arrival time is Sunday afternoon, from 2 pm. Pizza will be available at the Backpackers for dinner that evening, but subsequent evening meals will be at the RSA hall. The cost of pizza on the first night is included in the foray cost, but drinks can be purchased separately from the bar.

The foray programme will involve daily collecting, identification, and provision of display tables of the day's finds, with a day set aside for a colloquium.

Accommodation:

We have booked the entire Backpackers for the week, but numbers are limited so places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, as registrations are received. **Note especially that registrations received after April 20, 2012 may not be accommodated.** The Backpackers provides shared accommodation in a variety of single, bunk and double bed configurations, with communal bathroom/toilet facilities. Linen, pillows and towels are supplied. Meals:

Breakfast will be catered by the Fungal Foray organisers (the Backpackers is equipped with a large kitchen with crockery, cutlery etc). Lunches and dinners (after the first pizza night) will be catered at the RSA by a local caterer).

Packed lunches will be provided to all participants each morning.

Dinner: 6:00 pm

As the RSA is a licensed club, we are not permitted to bring our own alcohol, but it can be purchased from the adjacent bar and taken through to the microscope hall, and the Globe Backpackers has a bar as well. There is a supermarket and other services in Riverton.

Please indicate on the registration form if you have any special dietary needs (vegetarian, lactose-free, gluten-free etc). The caterer will endeavour to fulfil special meal requirements but these should be advised in advance. Gluten-free pizzas can be made available on request for the first night.

Colloquium day:

Wednesday 9th May will be set-aside for the *Mycology Colloquium* where participants can present talks on any aspect of mycology. Length of presentations will generally be 15–20 minutes including questions, but this will be confirmed closer to the time when we know how many speakers there are. The Colloquium/Conference will be held in the RSA Memorial Club Hall. Participants wishing to present a talk are invited to submit a **title and abstract** with their registration form or email it to David Orlovich (david.orlovich@otago.ac.nz) by **20**th **April 2012.**

For fungal foray participants, the cost of the Colloquium day is covered in the fees. If attending the Colloquium day only, a

charge of \$20 (includes morning/afternoon tea, lunch) will be levied.

Transportation:

For overseas participants, please correspond with us so that we can advise internal travel options. The nearest airport is at Invercargill.

Student Subsidies: We are happy to subsidise a limited number of New Zealand students wishing to attend the foray. The subsidy will be for the accommodation and facility cost. It does not include transportation or meals. Please apply early. More information is available from David Orlovich (david.orlovich@otago.ac.nz).

Registration: Please register for the foray by completing the registration form and return it by 20 April 2012.

Payment:
